Since the last council I have been busy nonstop on multiple large projects. One of the biggest projects over the last 2 weeks that I have personally been working on is the green impact excellence award which is a national award that we have submitted a proposal in for. Our idea is a computer recycling scheme which will help the environment, along with giving volunteers real world experience and helping out our local community but delivering refurbished PCs to local charities.

I have been working with the university on the reporting our goals and milestones against the student experience strategy which the students union has made great progress on so far early into the strategy. Majority of these goals are around STARs, employability, advice centre appointments, students attending events.
